Testing is barrier-free and is open seven days a week.

Everyone is welcome. You do not need to have symptoms to be tested.

You do not need insurance. If you have insurance, bring your card.

Do not eat, drink or smoke for 30 minutes before your test.

Testing is one of the best ways to stop the spread of COVID-19.
