

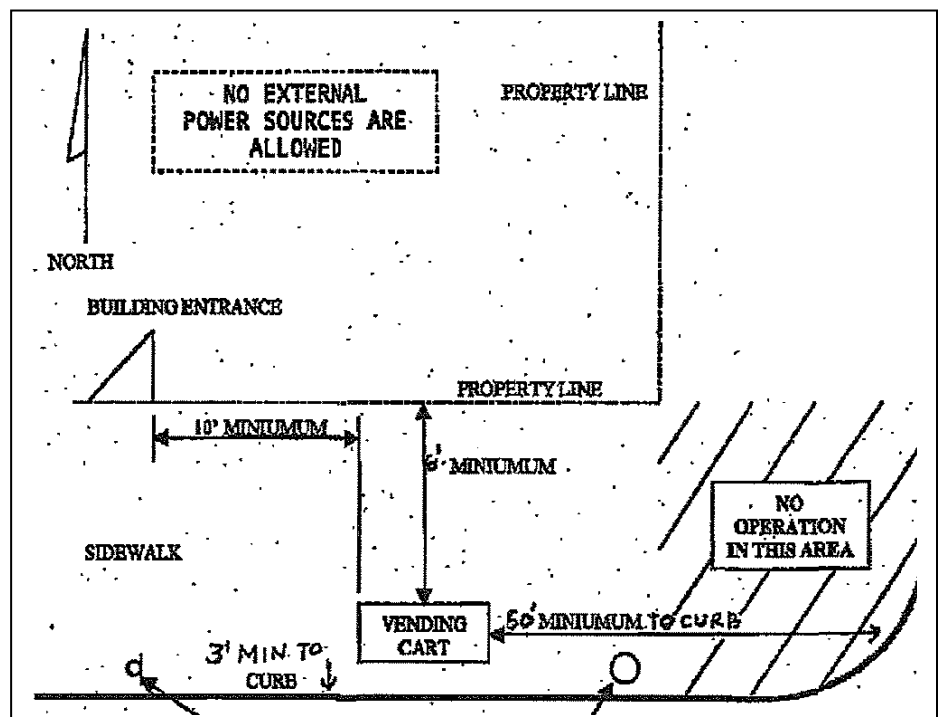
Sidewalk Food Cart Site Plan Requirements

1. Sidewalk food carts are only allowed to operate at pre-approved locations on commercial corridors throughout Minneapolis as defined in Minneapolis Code of Ordinances Chapter 188.510(5).
2. Sidewalk food carts cannot substantially impair the movement of pedestrians or vehicles or pose a hazard to public safety. A pedestrian walkway of no less than six (6) feet must be maintained around the cart.
3. Sidewalk food carts cannot be located
 - a. adjacent to a bus stop, taxi stand, or handicap loading zone;
 - b. within 50 feet of an intersection or within three feet of a curb; or
 - c. directly in front of a commercial entryway.

Site Plan Requirements

1. Draw a site plan to scale showing the sidewalk food cart location in relation to fixed elements on the sidewalk. This must be submitted on 8 ½" x 11" paper. Include DBA, vending site address and the name and telephone number of the contact person.
2. Label street names and the location where the sidewalk food cart will be parked.
3. Include measurements of the distance from the site to:
 - a. sidewalk intersection
 - b. adjacent property line
 - c. disabled parking and/or access ramp
 - d. building entrance
 - e. news racks
 - f. parking meters
 - g. street lights
 - h. signposts
 - i. light poles
 - j. bike stands
 - k. trees
 - l. fire hydrants
 - m. planters
 - n. bus shelters
 - o. other fixtures
