OVERVIEW OF THE COMPLAINT

It is alleged that the officer failed to write a supplement per policy.

ALLEGED VIOLATIONS

1. MPD P&P § 7-406.04 (7) - Role Of The Pursuit Supervisor: The pursuit supervisor shall: Make a statement in CAPRS regarding their involvement in the pursuit.

COMPLAINT PROCESSING

A complaint was forwarded from Internal Affairs—by way of the Minneapolis Police Department’s Pursuit Review Committee—to the Office of Police Conduct Review. Upon review, the joint supervisors sent the matter to coaching.

EVIDENCE

1. Memo/Complaint
2. VisiNet

SUMMARY OF EVIDENCE

1. Complaint: During a pursuit review, the Pursuit Review Committee found that a supervisor did not complete a CAPRS statement as required under policy.
2. CAPRS: No supplement is provided from Focus Officer in the report.

COACHING

The supervisor both coached the officer and found a policy violation in relation to the lack of supplement. According to the supervisor, Focus Officer told him that she thought that only the completion of a memo was necessary.
