THIRD AMENDMENT NOTICE**

WHEN: Public Comment period December 28, 2020 - January 5, 2021 with a Public Hearing at the Business, Inspections, Housing, & Zoning (BIHZ) Committee meeting January 5, 2021

PURPOSE: To provide public notice of a proposed Amendment to receive CARES Act supplemental funding provided through Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA-CV), and to receive public comment on HOPWA-CV funding allocations.

The City of Minneapolis invites you to review and comment on Minneapolis’ proposed third Amendment to the FY 2020 Consolidated Plan Action Plan. The Amendment outlines uses of \$252,199 in supplemental HOPWA-CV funds from the federal CARES Act in response to COVID-19 pandemic effects on persons with HIV.
