

Job Title: Gender Justice Intern
Hours: 6-8 hours/week, Remote Work

Asian American Organizing Project (AAOP) seeks two Gender Justice Interns to lead a research project on Sexual Education that is LGBTQ+ and APIDA centered. The fellowship will expand and build upon AAOP's existing research, identify and meet with key community partners, and develop curriculum and facilitate 2 -4 workshops. The position reports to the Gender Justice Organizer.

Duties

- Research and compile existing queer-centered/comprehensive sex ed curriculum
- Further synthesizing data from past AAOP Participatory Action Research projects to identify 3- 4 topics to expand on
- Build relationships and identify key strategic partnership and goals
- Develop a series of 3-4 workshops based on gaps identified in sex ed curricula

Work Stages:

Stage 1: Define comprehensive sex-ed and further research plan (9/8 - 10/8) (6-8 hrs per week)

- Re orient with sex ed and allyship research projects
- Define and language build
- Identify existing work around sex-ed
- Schedule 1:1's and partnerships
- Identify and execute any further research

Stage 2: Drafting sex-ed curriculum (10/8-11/8) (6 hrs/week)

- Identifying 3-4 topics to develop workshops based on
- Presenting curriculum to staff and incorporating feedback from AAOP staff and program leaders
- Research legalities of teaching and providing sex-ed to minors

Stage 3: Develop next steps for conducting and distributing curriculum

- Set date for final program presentation with feedback (between Nov 18-20)
- Next steps for workshop series into Jan and Feb 2021 (by December 11th)
