**SUMMARY OF COMPLAINT**

Complainant is a parent filing a complaint on behalf of their teenage child. The complainant alleges they were on the phone with their child who was working with officers to understand the status of their vehicle (whether it had been towed or stolen). During the interaction the complainant alleges that an officer used profane language while referring to the composure and demeanor of the teenage.

*2) VIDEO ANALYST REVIEW*

- a) Body Worn Camera (BWC) Review
  - i) A search for BWC activations related to this interaction yielded negative results.
- b) Squad Video Review
  - i) Squad video was not active at the time of the incident.

*3) CASE REVIEW & JOINT SUPERVISOR ROUTING*

- a) After reviewing the relevant and available evidence collected during intake, the Joint Supervisors agreed the complaint should be referred to the precinct for coaching.

**CASE OUTCOME**

*4) OFFICE OF POLICE CONDUCT REVIEW*

- a) Coaching documents were sent to the precinct on August 11, 2021.

*5) MINNEAPOLIS POLICE DEPARTMENT*

- a) Precinct supervisors returned the coaching documents, indicating the officer had been coached regarding the use of derogatory, indecent, profane, or unnecessarily harsh language while in the performance of their official duties or while representing the MPD.
