- A rainleader disconnection permit must be obtained before work can begin.
- A licensed plumber must be present for inspection of disconnection work.

## RAINLEADER DISCONNECTION PERMIT APPLICATION Rainleader Disconnection Permit Requirements:

- There is no fee for a Commercial Rainleader Disconnection Permit
- A rainleader disconnection permit is valid only for the disconnection work being performed. It does not eliminate the need for additional permits required by this Minneapolis Code of Ordinances or other governmental agencies.
- A permit is valid for one year, or as other wise specified.
- All work must be done in accordance with State and City rules and in a competent manner.
- Work must be permanent, no temporary caps or plugs such as internal gripper plugs.
- Work must be inspected before being covered up or concealed.
- Any previously allowed or permitted to connections to the sanitary sewer shall be disconnected.
- Any disconnected drain shall be directed so as not to cause flooding or water damage in any portion of the building or in any adjacent building, structure or property.
- Any previous disconnection work that does not meet these standards will also require a rainleader disconnection permit to complete work needed to comply with this ordinance
- A permit from the City Utility Connections office<sup>1</sup> is also required:
  - 1. To make alterations or repairs to an existing sewer lateral.
  - 2. To make a new connection to the Minneapolis Sanitary or Storm Drain System.
  - 3. To excavate in the City right-of-way.
- An owner-occupant of a single-family dwelling may perform work in their dwelling, all other work must be done by a licensed plumbing contractor.
- Any disconnection, plugging, capping, rerouting, altering, or modifying must be done in accordance with all applicable state rules and Minneapolis ordinances.

Time Extension Permits: Request a Time Extension Application by calling the Rainleader Disconnect Program at 612-673-5899. A \$25 filing fee payable to Minneapolis Finance Department must accompany the application.

\*The Request Number is located on the front of the official notice letter from City of Minneapolis. If you have not received an official notice, a Request Number will be provided with your permit.
