Project goal:

The basins on Grand Avenue were previously planted with seed, which yielded mixed results. Learning from the initial Grand Avenue installation and other projects, this restoration will use larger 3-4 inch container plants to ensure success.

What's next?

- Mid-April: Removing invasive vegetation, smoothing out rough areas, reducing steep slopes
- May: Begin installing native plants
- June-August: Continue planting basins, watering, weeding, and basin maintenance
- Park Board forestry will plant approximately 70 new trees and 70 replacement trees for those that did not survive.

Where will this impact?

Public Works will be restoring and maintaining rain gardens on Grand Avenue. We are asking residents to refrain from planting in these basins. We will not be doing any restoration in the remaining boulevard areas between the streets and sidewalk, which are the responsibility of the adjacent property

What can you do?

owners.

- Remove any vegetation you may have planted in a rain garden basin you wish to preserve.
