PREVENT A DRUG OVERDOSE DEATH



Steve's Law

Minnesota's Good Samaritan Law that protects people who are receiving and providing help for someone experiencing a drug overdose.

CALL 911

Allows protection for a person calling 911 to get help for an overdose

ADMINISTER NALOXONE

Allows first responders and community members to carry and give the lifesaving overdose drug Narcan/naloxone

NALOXONE

Naloxone is a lifesaving drug that can immediately reverse an opioid overdose.

You are Protected

Both the person having a drug overdose and the person getting help have limited protection from charges related to possession of drugs. protection is given for:

- Up to 3 grams of heroin, cocaine, or methamphetamine
- Up to 5 grams of fentanyl
- Up to 10 grams of other narcotics
- Up to 10 kilograms of marijuana
