





How Minnesota Compares

	Home Ownership rate	Proportion of adults working	Poverty rate
Minnesota (all)	1 st (highest)	4 th	11 th
Non-Hispanic White	3 rd	5 th	9 th
Of Color	45 th	22 nd	30 th
Gap White – Of Color	50 th (worst)	46 th	44 th



Proportion of adults (age 16-64) working for pay


	Rate in MN	MN's Rank among counter-parts in other states


