SUMMARY OF COMPLAINT

Complaint alleges that both Officer 1 and Officer 2 failed to complete a state accident report.

SUMMARY OF INVESTIGATION

1) INTAKE INVESTIGATION

a) VisiNet report

- i) The “Problem” is listed as “Property Damage Accident”. The call log indicates both officers were in the same squad and responded with third officer. It also indicates no injuries were reported.
