

School-Based Clinics Pre-Packaged Point of Care Pharmaceutical RFA

RFA Posted September 2, 2020 Responses to Questions

- 1. Is the Average Cost requested in Column D the bidders proposed cost for one ‘packaged, labeled and ready to dispense’ unit (1 vial of 25 caps of Acyclovir 200mg, 1 vial of 15 Ibuprofen 800mg tabs, etc)?**

Yes, applicants should include the cost for 1 unit as described in the “Size, Form, Strength” column.

- 2. Is the Available to Purchase requested in Column E the number of units required in Order Quantity Column C?**

Column E, “Available to Purchase” asks if the applicant currently sells the pharmaceutical, not necessarily the quantity available to purchase. The “Order Quantity” is the average amount purchased in a year by the Minneapolis School Based Clinics.

- 3. Will the OTC products listed (Cal Cit/Vit D, Multivit Fe) be required to have an additional pharmacy dispensing label?**

No, any over the counter product does not need to have an additional label.

- 4. Will orders be ‘placed by’ and ‘shipped to’ each individual site or to a central location?**

The Minneapolis School Based Clinics distributes from a single location to all clinic sites. Orders will be placed by one site to represent all clinic locations.

- 5. Are the Minneapolis School Based Clinics open to suggestions from vendors on lower cost or other alternatives to pharmaceuticals?**

Yes, the Minneapolis School Based Clinics welcome any cost saving suggestions from vendors.
