



2021 CONSOLIDATED PLAN ACTION PLAN NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

PURPOSE: To receive comment on the City's Proposed 2021 Consolidated Plan Action Plan for CDBG, HOME, ESG, and HOPWA federal entitlement funding.

Dear Interested Individual/Agency:

You are invited to comment on Minneapolis' proposed FY 2021 Consolidated Plan Action Plan. The Action Plan covers the City's application for 2021 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), Emergency Solutions Grant Program (ESG), and the Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) federal entitlement funding. The Action Plan is the second year of Minneapolis' Five-Year Strategy for these funds.

The Consolidated Plan Action Plan is an application to the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) describing the City's housing and community development strategies for low- and moderate-income residents at or below 80 percent of the metropolitan area median income level.

We invite your participation by speaking at the hearing and/or submitting written comments before, during, or after the hearing on **May 4, 2021**.
