Guidelines for City of Minneapolis Buildings



Organics recycling is available in all City owned buildings. Paper cups, plates, bowls, and utensils put in the organics recycling bins must be certified compostable. City staff and other organizations providing food and beverages in City buildings can support the City's organics recycling efforts by using the following guide to select certified compostable foodservice items.



Organics Recycling Foodservice Guidelines

Accepted

- ✓ BPI Certified products
- ✓ Unlined and uncoated paper products (napkins, plates)



Not Accepted

- Plastic silverware not certified compostable
- Decorative paper plates
- Coffee cups not certified compostable
- Paper coated with foil
- Plastic, including Styrofoam[™], chip bags and plasticcoated items
- Items labeled "made with plants" or "biodegradable"
 WITHOUT a compostable certification

The <u>Green to Go Ordinance</u> requires food and beverages prepared for immediate consumption and togo to be placed in environmentally acceptable packaging. Environmentally acceptable packaging is reusable, recyclable or compostable.
