The Data Practices Office, on behalf of the Commissioner of Administration, has received the Minneapolis Police Department's automated license plate reader biennial audit report.

As required by law, the review of the report summarizing the results of the audit covers the audit of records to determine whether data currently in the records are classified, how the data are used, whether data are destroyed as required, and that the audit verified the Department's compliance with data accuracy, protection, and legitimate access procedures and applicable data breach notification requirements.
