May 11	Closing date for candidate applications for Districts 2,4, 6 and 8
May 18	Voter Guide on-line and mailed to Neighborhoods
June 8	Deadline for notifying NCR of neighborhood electors and alternates
June 14	Commission elections in District 2, 4, 6 and 8

June 18	Announce winners
June 26	NCEC meeting - new members encouraged to attend as observers
July 13	Orientation for new members

July 24	NCEC Meeting – new members seated
