## Background

The City's Community Planning and Economic Development (CPED) department has released Minneapolis 2040. Minneapolis 2040 is a draft Comprehensive Plan that shapes how the city will grow and change. The draft covers topics such as housing, job access, the design of new buildings, and how we use our streets. Over the past two years, the people of Minneapolis have told us a lot about their vision and hopes for the future of our city. A main theme we heard is that as the city grows, everyone must benefit from that growth. Historically, not everyone has. This draft plan is one opportunity to undo barriers and overcome inequities created by a history of policies in our city that have prevented equitable access to housing, jobs, and investments.

The City is currently reaching out to the Minneapolis community to discuss this draft plan and to encourage review and feedback.

Brey Golding, a City Planner from CPED's Long Range Planning department will be sharing with the Commission an update on the draft plan and the ways residents can give input on the draft plan.
