Requested Action:

The commission shall agree to approve the funding recommendations submitted from the One Minneapolis Fund Committee as a package through a yes or no vote.

Committee Purpose:

The Committee will make recommendations to the NCEC and NCR department on guidelines for the One Minneapolis Fund, develop a request for proposals for funding applications and review applications and make recommendations to the on projects to receive funding from the program. The final recommendations will be sent to the City Council for final adoption.

Background:

In April of 2012 the One Minneapolis Fund Task Force was established (originally called the Addressing Community Programming Task Force). The Charge for the Task Force was amended in November 2012 to extend the duration of the Task Force until March 2013. In November 2013 the Task Force was converted into an ongoing committee to reflect the continuing nature of the One Minneapolis Fund.

Charge/Deliverables:

- Program guidelines and request for proposals
- Funding recommendations.

Membership:

The Task Force will be comprised of up to eight members.

NCR staff will support the activities of the Committee.

Duration/Anticipated time commitment:

The committee will continue through the duration of the One Minneapolis Fund program.
