## Background

On Friday, October 5<sup>th</sup> the Minneapolis City Council approved a new grievance policy for the Community Participation program guidelines. With the new adoption of the policy, there is now a requirement for a standing Grievance Panel consisting of five members and two alternates.

Once Grievance Panel members are selected, the Neighborhood and Community Relations department will work with a 3<sup>rd</sup> party consultant to provide the necessary training and manuals as the new policy requires to the Grievance Panel members and alternates.
