MARQUETTE AND 2ND AVENUE SOUTH PAVEMENT REPAIRS PROJECT

Marquette and 2nd Avenue South Pavement Repair to begin on June 11

Concrete removal and concrete patching will be starting on June 11 on 2nd Avenue beginning at 11th and 10th Street South. Construction will be occurring in two to three block segments for approximately two to three weeks at a time.

What to expect during construction

- During construction, there will be an increase in traffic congestion, noise, vibration, and dust in work areas.
- Vehicle traffic will be detoured from the 2-3 block work area for approximately two weeks as concrete repairs are being completed.
- There may be delayed access to parking ramps, valets, and loading dock to accommodate concrete removal and concrete patching.
- Changes and delays to bus services will be minimized to the extent possible.

Construction activities are subject to change due to weather, schedule and unforeseen circumstances.

MARQ2: Is a pavement repair project led by the City of Minneapolis Public Works. The project includes pavement repairs on Marquette and 2nd Avenue between 1st and 12th Street South. This work is being done to replace temporary pavement restoration which was the result of recently completed underground utility work. The City has proposed a five-year moratorium on roadway upon completion of pavement repair in Fall 2018.
