

RAIL ROAD CROSSING UPGRADE ON 26TH AVE N BETWEEN PACIFIC ST AND 2ND ST N

Starting the week of August 12, 2019 City crews will be working between Pacific St and 2nd Ave N. This work will involve realigning the bicycle path behind the signals and removing pavement in preparation for CP Rail to install a new RR crossing surface. This work will take 3-4 weeks and traffic will be detoured around the work.

WHAT TO EXPECT

The detour route will be from Pacific St to 28th St to 2nd St N, and will go into effect the week of August 12.

Week of August 12th - The bike path, sidewalk and roadway pavement adjacent to the RR tracks will be removed. And possible storm sewer work will be completed.

Week of August 19th – Canadian Pacific Railroad will begin removals and preparations for installing the new crossing.

Week of August 26th – Canadian Pacific completes crossing, City of Minneapolis patches in roadway, sidewalk and bike path. Note: the concrete roadway will require 7 days to cure and reach an acceptable strength before 26th Ave N can be reopened to traffic.

All solid waste and recycling pickup dates will not change and crews will pick up at the usual locations.
