



Minneapolis Tobacco Dealer Youth Tobacco Prevention Check List

The Minneapolis Tobacco Free Campaign has created an easy to use checklist for tobacco dealers to help prevent youth tobacco use. Thank you for helping keep our kids safe and tobacco free.

Please:

- ✓ Do not sell cigarettes, tobacco products or devices*, including cigarillos, shisha or electronic cigarettes to any person under the age of 18
- ✓ Please check a photo ID of everyone appearing to be under the age of 27 that attempts to purchase cigarettes or other tobacco products and devices
- ✓ Do not sell single cigarettes, often called “loosies”
- ✓ Do not sell any tobacco products, including electronic cigarettes, in a self-service display where customers can help themselves (unless you are a licensed Tobacco Product Shop as defined in Minneapolis law 281.15)
- ✓ Do not give away free samples of tobacco
- ✓ Do not cover more than 30% of your exterior windows with signage
- ✓ Do not allow persons under 18 into the store if you are a Tobacco Product Shop (as defined in Minneapolis law 281.15)

*Tobacco products and devices include: cigarettes, cigars, snuff, hookah tobacco (narghile, argile, shisha, hubble-bubble and goza), pipes, rolling papers, rolling machines, lobelia or nicotine based electronic cigarettes.
