- Free healthy home assessment services (valued at \$500 per dwelling unit).
- The City of Minneapolis **may** grant up to \$12,000 per dwelling unit for rental properties for lead hazard reduction activities.
- Health and safety corrections/supplies to the property valued up to \$1,500 per dwelling unit (for example: mold remediation, electrical, plumbing repairs, or supplies such as vacuum cleaner, air filters etc.).
- Free clearance testing valued at \$300 per dwelling unit will be provided by the City of Minneapolis for each enrolled dwelling unit.
- Free Home Energy Squad visit from Center for Energy and Environment (valued at\$100).
