- Health and safety corrections/supplies to the property valued up to \$1,500 per dwelling unit (for example: mold remediation, electrical, plumbing repairs, or supplies such as vacuum cleaner, air filters etc.).
- Free clearance testing valued at \$300 per dwelling unit will be provided by the City of Minneapolis for each enrolled dwelling unit.
- Free Home Energy Squad visit from Center for Energy and Environment (valued at \$100).
