Eligibility Requirements

- Pre-1978 construction
- A child under the age of 6 **must** reside at the property
- Income qualifications for tenants or homeowners below:

Grant Awards

- Grant money is available to both owner occupied and rental unit
- Up to \$12,000 per dwelling unit to repair identified lead hazards
- Free lead and healthy homes assessment provided by the Minneapolis Health Department
- Free EPA Renovation, Repair and Painting (RRP) training course for property owners (\$200 Value)

Property owner requirements

- Attend an 8 hour RRP course
- Responsible for costs beyond the grant cap of \$12,000
- Rental owners required to pay a match of 10%, 20% or 50% of repair costs
