Recruiting Strategies: Hiring Tips and Talent Sourcing

Examine your talent sourcing and hiring practices, ensuring strong candidates are identified regardless of employment status at the time of application.

Train hiring managers and recruiters to *avoid negative judgment of employment gaps*, as this practice can potentially lead to the exclusion of wellqualified applicants.

Post openings, interview and hire based on candidate competencies related to the *key skills* for each open job.
