- 3rd quarter assessments will be finalized the week of January 23-27.
- Minneapolis Employment and Training issued a RFP on January 9, soliciting organizations to provide education, employment and training services to 14-24 year old youth and young adults funded via the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA). Proposals are due at 4:00 PM on February 10.
- The RFP process that Minneapolis Employment and Training utilized has changed given the transition from the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) to WIOA.
- WIOA eliminates the Youth Council requirement; however, Department of Labor encourages Workforce Development Boards (WDBs) to establish a Standing Youth Committee.
- Standing Youth Committee Has flexibility in membership and should reflect the needs of the local area and must include:
  - Member of local WDB as chair
  - Community-based organizations with record of success
  - Others with appropriate expertise and experience
  - WDBs may designate existing effective Youth Council as Standing Youth Committee.
- Whether or not there is a Standing Youth Committee, the WDB is still responsible for conducting oversight of youth workforce investment activities under WIOA and identifying eligible providers of youth workforce investment activities in the Workforce Development Area by awarding grants or contracts of a competitive basis.

#### Other Updates

Build Leaders

Minneapolis Employment and Training received \$362,000 through the 2017 City's budget process to continue BUILD Leaders programming. BUILD is a proven youth violence prevention model developed in Chicago and adapted for Minneapolis.

Staff from EMERGE Community Development and American Indian OIC (in partnership with Little Earth of United Tribes) are currently recruiting participants for Cohort 2. Program activities will begin in February.
