



## 2021 CONSOLIDATED PLAN ACTION PLAN AMENDMENT PUBLIC HEARING

**WHEN:** Tuesday, February 28, 2023, at 1:30 p.m. before the Business, Inspections, Housing and Zoning (BIHZ) Committee.

**PURPOSE:** To receive comment on the City's Proposed 2021 Consolidated Plan Action Plan Amendment HOME-ARP Allocation Plan.

You are invited to comment on Minneapolis' development of a HOME Investment Partnerships American Rescue Plan (HOME-ARP) allocation plan as an amendment to the City's 2021 Consolidated Plan Action Plan.

HOME-ARP is a one-time funding award of \$9,626,335 made to the City by the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development. The Allocation Plan will outline the City's investment priorities for funding four activities that must primarily benefit qualifying individuals and families who are homeless, at risk of homelessness, or in other vulnerable populations such as veterans or those seeking a housing exit from domestic violence. These activities include:

- (1) development and support of affordable housing,
- (2) tenant-based rental assistance,
- (3) provision of supportive services, and
- (4) acquisition and development of non-congregate shelter units.

After consulting with a series of community stakeholders, the City is interested in further hearing how the qualifying populations could benefit from HOME-ARP investments and which activities are best suited for a particular qualifying population.
