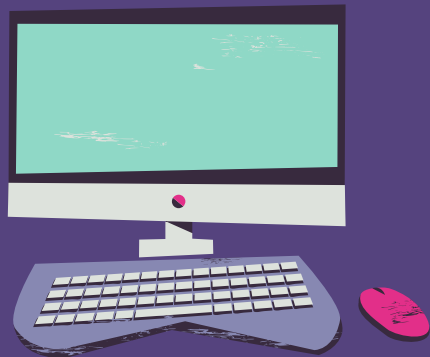
YOUTH EMPLOYED

Young people are matched with paid internships that provide a foundational work experience, intentional mentoring, and a resume-building professional experience.

The Online Career Exploration Pathway created in response to the Covid-19 pandemic as an alternative paid opportunity for participants who weren't matched with an internship. Participants could earn up to \$600 for completing the five-week virtual career exploration experience.

YOUTH EARNED A TOTAL OF

\$2,072,719

Over 82 employers - private sector, non profit, and public - hired and paid or hosted subsidized interns. Employers paid \$1,093,145 directly to interns and the remaining \$979,574 was supported with local, state or federal funds.

329 interns, ages 14-15 earned a combined **\$630,474**

396 interns, ages 16-21 earned a combined **\$1,093,145**

631 youth earned a stipend in the CEP program totaling **\$349,100**

ACADEMIC CREDIT

Eligible participants can earn up to a semester's work of elective high school academic credit for completing Work Readiness training, and/or the online Career Exploration Program.
